Shoplifter – Macquarie Park

About 3.30pm on Thursday 27 September, a 23-year-old man from Marsfield has entered a supermarket in Macquarie Park

The man has placed a number of items into a trolley he was pushing, attended the self serve check out. He was observed by the Loss Prevention Officer to place several items into his trolley without scanning the items.

The man has then exited the store without making any attempts to pay for the items. He was stopped by the Loss Prevention Officer and taken escorted to the security office to await the arrival of police.

Police spoke with the man before issuing him with a Criminal Infringement Notice for shoplifting.

Man Charged with Low Range PCA – Hunters Hill

About 9.00am Monday 1 October 2018, Police were conducting stationary random breath testing Southbound on Burns Bay Road Hunters Hill, when they stopped a 26-year-old man from Quakers Hill for a breath test.

The man returned a positive roadside test and was arrested and taken to Ryde Police Station to undergo a breath analysis.

The driver returned a reading of 0.056 and was issued with a Court Attendance Notice for Drive with Low Range PCA.

He will now appear in Burwood Local Court on 12 November 2018.

“P2” Plate driver Charged with Mid Range PCA – Ryde

About 5.40am Sunday 30 September 2018, Police were patrolling Blaxland Road, Ryde when they stopped a vehicle Northbound for a random breath test.

The man returned a positive roadside test and was arrested and taken to Ryde Police Station to undergo a breath analysis.

The “P2” driver returned a reading of 0.097 and was issued with a Court Attendance Notice for Drive with Mid Range PCA.

He will now appear in Burwood Local Court on 5 November 2018.

Drug detection – North Ryde

About 12.10am on Tuesday 2 October 2018, Police attached to Ryde LAC were patrolling Joubert St, Hunters Hill.

Police observed man at the location. Police stopped and approached the man

As a result of the conversation the police have had with the man he was searched.
