## THE M2 NORTH WEST TRANSPORT LINK

The Trust was represented by **Jocelyn Lloyd & Paul Goodrick** at the inaugural meeting of the Local Liaison Group 3 for the M2 North West Transport Link. Group 3 is concerned with the area from the Railway Line at Epping to Pennant Hills Road.

The purpose of this group is to "seek views from the local community concerning the design and construction of the M2 project" (Draft guidelines for the Local Liaison Groups). The Hills Motorway Consortium has appointed **Barry Rosewarn** as its community officer. His brief is to listen to and respond to peoples' suggestions and concerns about the M2 Link. The Centre is open during business hours on weekdays and 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. on Saturdays.
