HOUSING AND PLANNING REVISION

Statements made at the Trust August General Meeting by Mr Sean O'Toole, Assistant Director, N.S.W. Department of Planning, were welcomed by the Trust.

Eastwood, Epping, Cheltenham, Beecroft and Pennant Hills have been removed from the list of 47 removed from the list of 47 railway stations classified as under utilized. utilized.

This means that the areas within one kilometre of these stations are no longer under general than one kilometre of these stations are no longer under consideration for rezoning.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

A recent survey of residential properties in the PH/2 Neighbourhood sold area revealed that approving the ph/2 Neighbourhood had been Watch area revealed that approximately 26% of properties had been sold over the last six years. sold over the last six years.
