#### The Proposed Mobile Phone Tower at Pennant Hills Golf Club

Pennant Hills Golf Club and Telecommunications carriers Telstra and Vodaphone lave done and telecommunications carriers and vodaphone phone lave done a deal and propose to construct a 35m high mobile phone elecommunications carriers leistra and vocaphine phone and propose to construct a 35m high mobile phone elecommunications. elecommunications tower with 15 antennae on Golf Club land within 30 metres of residential dwellings in Burns Road South, Beecroft; an area highly populated with children

Resident objection does not lie with the construction of the Tower itself, merely its location

At a meeting at Hornsby Shire Council on 18th September, 1996 the proposal to construct the month. construct the mobile phone telecommunications tower was UNANIMOUSLY rejected on the rejected on the grounds that the proposed tower is in close proximity to residential dwelling. residential dwellings; whilst there is sufficient area available within the 39Ha site to relocate the site to relocate the proposed tower away from residential dwellings.
