Thank you for your representations of 10 February 2025, to Hon Prue Car MP, Deputy Premier and Minister for Education and Early Learning, on behalf of the Beecroft Cheltenham Civic Trust, regarding facilities at Cheltenham Girls High School. The Deputy Premier has asked me to respond on her behalf.

NSW public schools are the lifeblood of our communities, and the Department of Education wants to ensure teachers and students feel proud to study and work in them. The NSW Government is investing record funding into minor works and capital maintenance projects to lift the standards of important school facilities.

I have asked School Infrastructure to inspect the toilets at Cheltenham Girls High School and discuss upgrade and maintenance priorities with the Principal. I am pleased to confirm that a meeting was held at the school on 18 March 2025 and an upgrade to the toilets is being delivered under the 2024/25 Planned Maintenance program.
